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SUMMARY OF THE SOLICITATION

In East Africa it is estimated that over 10,000 people will be taught the TM program within the next 5 years. Integral to this development, an estimated 2,000 new TM Sidhas will also be instructed.

During the past 5 years over \$500,000 of early stage investments have been made in TM projects in Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania and Zambia. These funds were organized by three non-profit organizations based in Fairfield, Iowa, USA: Partners for World Peace, Seeds of Heaven and PTSD Relief Now. As a result, more than 2,500 people have learned TM and a further 300 have become TM Sidhas.

In addition to providing TM and TM Sidhi instruction, investments to date have supported delivery of Consciousness-Based EducationSM and various physical infrastructure needs for schools; expanded economic opportunity among women's groups; and reduced PTSD symptoms in groups of children and adults at risk. In the most holistic sense, these developments represent the establishment of "Coherence Communities" to stabilize and enrich the collective consciousness of East Africa.

The current solicitation represents the next stage of development for these Coherence Communities, specifically seeking funding for the annual period of 2018.

As many donors have noted, their investments have been uniquely cost effective in reaching very large numbers of people. An invested dollar "goes a long way" in East Africa toward creating these Coherence Communities compared to the same amount invested in many other parts of the world.

FUNDS MANAGEMENT: This solicitation is being issued solely by Partners for World Peace (PWP) in Fairfield, IA., to which the funds will be paid directly. PWP will then be responsible for holding and transferring these funds into the TM Program NGOs established in each of these East African countries. The President and Board of Directors of PWP will take responsibility for approving such transfers, against pre-approved project budgets. The Board of Directors for PWP are:

HISTORY OF THE E. AFRICAN PROJECTS:

The Global Country of World Peace, a non-profit corporation or non-governmental organization based in The Netherlands has operated for over 25 years in most of these E. African countries through local Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs). Over the years, there have been many projects initiated with varying degrees of success, but in the last few years, under the guidance of the Rajas and the Rajeshwaries, the opportunities for development have received much more detailed supervision and oversight leading to a greater receptivity to these programs. This is an indication that something good is happening in this region of the world.

E. Africa has been experiencing a refinement of their collective consciousness. This is evidenced in the greater stability of the governments, the improving economies, enhanced communication systems, increased cultivation of organic agriculture and an expanding middle class. All these trends suggest a positive growth pattern for the region and seem to indicate an area set for rapid economic expansion in the coming decades.

Motivated by these changes over the past 5 years, there has been an increased investment of over \$500,000 into these E. African projects coming primarily through the inspiration of the Global Country of World Peace and their affiliation with Partners for World Peace and two other non-profit organizations, all based in Fairfield, Iowa, USA, that have taken on the responsibility to fund and administer these investments.

A brief profile follows for each non-profit organization.

Seeds of Heaven (SOH): This Iowa non-profit corporation functions as a conduit and clearinghouse for fundraising and is utilized by many Rajas and Rajeshwaries, for projects around the world. Donations in excess of \$600,000 are processed each year through SOH. Raja Graham and Leanne de Freitas are the founders and there is a local board of directors made up of TM Governors who oversee the strategic functions of this organization.

Partners for World Peace (PWP): This Iowa non-profit corporation functions as a fundraising entity for projects of the Global Country of World Peace. It also provides strategic consultation, financial planning and management oversight assistance for most projects undertaken by the GCWP. The international board of directors is comprised of TM Governors who oversee this organization.

PTSD Relief Now: This Iowa non-profit corporation functions as a fundraising and project oversight service group whose main focus is the African PTSD Relief program. A group of American and international TM Governors comprise its board of directors.

These three organizations will continue their ongoing support of all the projects listed in this solicitation, with future contributions comparable to those of recent years.

SUMMARY OUTLINE PER PROJECT

1. Liberty School—Nandi Hills, Kenya

Founded by: Elphaz Ronoh, TM Governor from Nandi Hills

Overview: After learning the TM program about 8 years ago and introducing TM to his primary school, Elphaz, along with two ladies, Elizabeth Melley and Monica Tiony attended the TM Teacher Training Course. Now a **Consciousness Based Education School**, Liberty School has 135 students and all the faculty, staff, administration and students practice the TM program. Over 600 people have learned the TM program in Nandi Hills.

Future Plans: In preparation for a new group of Sidhas, a flying hall has already been built. Now we need to fund TM Sidhi program training for members of the community

Community Support: Lady Governors oversee a club of women who gather weekly for group meditations and do projects together to further economic support for their families.

Three Funding Goals:

A) Support for the school

B) Support for the women's group of TM meditators

C) Sponsorship of instruction of the TM Sidhi and Yogic Flying program for the community.

2. PTSD Relief—Nakuru, Kenya

Project Leader: Simon Mwangi, long time TM Governor.

Street Children: PTSD relief project for street children. **SCANN**, one of 20 homes for street children in Nakuru, has received and established TM instruction for all the resident boys, plus the staff and administration. This funding will expand this project to two more homes.

Refugee PTSD Relief: TM project with South Sudanese refugees. This funding will expand this project to instruct 100 additional people in the TM Technique as well as support monthly follow-up for 100 meditators.

NGO: Support the creation of a new NGO for Nakuru to legally represent the evolving opportunity of supporting and offering the programs of the **Global Country of World Peace**.

TM Sidhis: Sponsor the first group of Nakuru TM meditators to receive the advanced TM Sidhi and Yogic Flying program.

Five Funding Goals:

- A) Support ongoing SCANN TM program
- B) Expand TM instruction and support to two more homes for street children
- C) Instruct and support 100 additional South Sudanese Refugees in TM Technique
- D) Create new NGO
- E) Sponsorship of instruction of the TM Sidhi and Yogic Flying program for Nakuru

3. Global One School—Nairobi, Kenya

TM Instructors: National Director, Solomon Mwangi, Patrick Kinuthia and Innocent Mwangi.

Overview: located in the Kibera slums of Nairobi—over 600,000 people inhabit the Kibera slums and an estimated 50% of this population is school age children. **Global One School** has adopted the TM program to combat PTSD. The entire primary school population, students, faculty and staff are all practicing the TM program. **The Global One** group is now building a secondary school. In 2018 they want all the students, faculty and staff of this secondary school to also learn the TM program.

Future Plans: Ongoing success with the TM program in the **Global One School** may inspire other schools in Kibera to incorporate the TM program and Consciousness Based Education into their schools.

TM Sidhis Instruction: Support an initial group at Global One to learn the TM Sidhis and Yogic Flying programs.

Three Funding Goals:

- A) Support ongoing Global One meditators

- B) TM instruction for Global One Secondary School
- C) TM Sidhi Instruction for group at Global One

4. **PTSD Relief—Transmara, Kenya:**

Overview: A PTSD relief project for a community on the Tanzanian border in south Kenya—exposed to tribal warfare. In three years, over 400 people have learned the TM program—and 200 more (mainly students) are ready to start TM. Four schools practice the TM program.

Future Plans: About 20 schools have shown interest in the TM program for their students.

TM Sidhis: Support an initial group of TM meditators to learn the TM Sidhi and Yogic Flying program.

Two Funding Goals:

- A) TM instruction for 200 and follow-up for all 600 meditators
- B) TM Sidhi instruction for an initial group of meditators

5. **Congolese Refugee Integrated Community—Kampala, Uganda:**

History: The local TM organization taught the TM program to a select group of Congolese refugees six years ago. The program was not followed up well. Starting in 2016 **Partners for World Peace** has supported the instruction of 450 Congolese refugees in the TM program. Combined with the 150 refugees who learned TM in the past there are now over 600 Congolese refugees who have learned the TM program.

Congolese Schools: The Congolese have their own secondary school where all practice the TM program. They have two primary schools now scheduled to learn the TM program.

Congolese Medical Clinic: Staffed by refugee doctors and nurses, all practice the TM program and are now recommending and guiding their patients to learn the TM program.

Women’s’ Community Support Group: There is a women’s group in this community which is also adopting the TM program.

Future Plans: Expansion of the TM and TM Sidhi program are anticipated by this Congolese refugee community. The community leadership and the Congolese Embassy in Kampala are very supportive of this initiative. This funding will further the efforts with the Congolese refugees in Kampala and help them establish themselves as a Coherence Community, which will be of dual value, both in the Ugandan and DR Congo collective consciousness.

Five Funding Goals:

- A) TM instruction and follow-up in Congolese Schools
- B) TM instruction and follow-up in Congolese Clinic

- C) Lab equipment for Congolese Clinic
- D) TM instruction and follow-up in Congolese women's groups
- E) TM instruction and follow-up in Congolese community

6. **Ideal Girls Secondary School—M'bali, Uganda**

Overview: Owned by Maharishi Education Development Ltd. in Uganda, this school was established by Grant Lusimbo, a long time TM Governor from Uganda. Both the Raja and Rajeshwari of Uganda have been big supporters of this school. The school has performed well in the governmental testing of students.

Buildings and Equipment: The international support group for this school has already built multiple buildings on the school grounds. This solicitation will allocate funds to help advance the capacity of this school to serve its students.

TM Sidhis: This school already has its own group practicing the TM Sidhi and Yogic Flying programs.

Funding Goal:

Sports Equipment and a Well for the School

7. **Brain Trust School – Kampala, Uganda**

Overview: A Muslim based secondary school, the owner of this school is a very strong meditator. He has been practicing TM for several years now and he wanted the TM program introduced to his students.

TM Follow-up: Over the past couple years the TM Program has been taught to over 100 parents associated with the school, plus 200 students, staff and faculty.

Funding Goal: Support ongoing follow up for TM in the school.

8. **Good Luck School – Kampala, Uganda**

Overview: The owner of this school is a strong meditator and he wanted the TM program taught to the students in his primary school. During 2017 about 50 faculty, staff and parents have been taught the TM program.

TM Instruction and Follow-up: The next step is to teach the 120 children at the school and provide follow up each month.

Funding Goal: Support TM instruction and follow-up.

9. **North Uganda Refugee Project—New Project**

Overview: This project will focus on refugees from warfare in North Uganda and South Sudan. There are over one million South Sudanese refugees who have migrated into

North Uganda because of civil war in their country. One TM Governor in Uganda (Ojimi) will move to North Uganda under this funding.

TM Instruction and Follow-up: Short visits to the region by the TM Governors in Uganda have produced an initial group of fifty people ready to learn the TM program. They are affiliated with a local NGO that addresses refugee issues. It is anticipated that this Governor will teach at least 400 refugees the TM program during 2018. This funding will allocate support for this Governor and his family to live in North Uganda in 2018 and introduce the TM program to a large number of refugees and provide follow up.

Funding Goal: Provide salary, rent and teaching expenses for 12 months

10. West Uganda—Kasese Primary School—New Project

Overview: Launched by Maharishi Education Development, Ltd. in Uganda, **Kasese Primary School** is scheduled to start classes in January, 2018. This newly emerging Coherence Community is located near the border of the DR Congo. Establishing more coherence in the collective consciousness of this location will be good for both Uganda and the DR Congo.

Project Leader: Bamande Tsongo, a TM Governor from Uganda plans to move back to this region with his family to operate this school. Bamande is originally from this region of the country and has many years' experience running TM programs in schools in Kampala.

School Building: The school building has ten classrooms and the landlord is the brother of Bamande.

TM Instruction: In addition to establishment of the school, Bamande will be active teaching many people in the Kasese community the TM program.

Funding Goal: Provide startup capital and operational subsidy for TM instruction and follow-up for 12 months.

11. Arash Pre-School and Primary School, Tanzania

Overview: An ongoing project in the area of Arash, Tanzania, a Maasai village area, very close to the Serengeti National Park. About 75 women in the local Minuatae Women's Group learned the TM program over the last three years.

Pre School and Primary School: In collaboration with the Maharishi Development Foundation in Tanzania, this group of Maasai women established a pre-school in 2016—where the staff and children are practicing the TM program and TM Walking program. The first grade of a primary school was also started in 2017. There are about 170 students in the three levels of this school thus far.

School Buildings: Arash village elders organized for the ladies group to receive 9 acres of donated lands to establish a permanent school. The Maharishi Development Foundation in Tanzania is working with the ladies group to establish a Consciousness

Based Primary School on this land and this funding will invest in establishment of select structures for starting this primary school.

TM Instruction: Support more people to learn the TM program and TM Sidhi program in Arash.

Community Support: Invest in microeconomic loans for the women's group in Arash—helping them evolve better economic support for their families.

Four Funding Goals:

- A) Support TM instruction and follow-up for adults and children
- B) Construct toilet, kitchen and simple residence on new school grounds
- C) Sponsor TM Sidhi instruction for an initial group of meditators
- D) Fund microeconomic loans for women's groups

12. Maasai Villages, North Tanzania

Overview: The TM program has been taught to over 500 people in multiple Maasai villages in north Tanzania, near Arusha, during the last three years. The people learning the TM program are mostly women—and the children of the women who have learned. The potential to teach a very large number of Maasai people the TM program in Tanzania is quite realistic.

Project Leaders: Penina Mollel—our only Maasai speaking TM Governor in the world and Poline Mbawala—who teaches in Swahili, a language common to East Africa.

TM Instruction and Follow-up: Provide follow up to TM instruction in these villages and teach hundreds more the TM program during 2018.

Community Support: Invest in microeconomic loans for multiple women's groups in the villages--helping them evolve better economic support for their families.

TM Sidhi Instruction: Support an initial group of meditators to learn the TM Sidhi and Yogic Flying programs in North Tanzania.

Three Funding Goals:

- A) Support TM instruction and follow-up
- B) Fund microeconomic loans for four women's groups
- C) Sponsor TM Sidhi instruction for initial group of meditators

13. Merirani, North Tanzania:

Overview: This village has a history of TM instruction. Over 400 people have learned the TM program in Merirani in the last five years. The people learning the TM program are mostly women—and the children of the women who have learned.

Project Leaders: Penina Mollel—our only Maasai speaking TM Governor in the world and Poline Mbawala—who teaches in Swahili, a language common to East Africa.

Community Support: Invest in microeconomic loans for the women's group in Merirani, helping them evolve better economic support for their families. Plus build a very simple

structure at the home of the local TM program organizer, to provide a local place in the town for the youth to come for group meditations.

TM Instruction: Support this emerging “coherence community” in Merirani with respect to follow up for the TM program.

Three Funding Goals:

- A) Support TM instruction and follow-up
- B) Fund microeconomic loans for four women’s groups
- C) Build a group program facility for the youth of the village.

14. Maharishi Model School, Lusaka, Zambia

Overview: Pre-school, kindergarten, primary and secondary school—established in the slums of Lusaka among an economically disadvantaged population. All the 293 students, the faculty, staff, administration and some of the parents have learned the TM program. Having received significant support from the Maharishi Foundation of the UK, **Maharishi Model School** continues to expand, and the prospects for considerable additional expansion are quite strong. In its current facilities the school can accommodate up to 500 students.

Project Leader: Harry Mwangala, the TM National Director of Zambia established Maharishi Model School in 2012

Expansion of enrollment: Invest in select items for the Maharish Model School which are strategically predicted to help the school expand its enrollment.

Four Funding Goals:

- A) Booklets
- B) Uniforms
- C) Desks
- D) Laptops
