We would like to introduce the newest board member of the PWP non-profit corporation, Pedro Ojeda, from Ascension, Paraguay. Pedro is the principle TM-Sidhi Administrator for all of Latin America and has been working in the TM organization for many decades, including many special projects for the International offices of the TM program. Pedro brings additional



perspective of Latin America to our board of directors of PWP and will especially assist us in our support of the history-making efforts to rapidly expand "coherence-creating groups" in the countries of Latin American.

Support For Southeast Asia

Thailand: The PWP Advocates for Girls group is actively promoting the Asian Mother Divine project for the Thailand Buddhist Nuns Girls School. This school has 550 girls who come from socially disadvantaged situations. All the girls practice the TM program and about 250 of them also practice the TM-Sidhi program. The PWP Advocates for Girls group, in concert with many others who are supporting this project, have helped to complete a new secondary level classroom building and are now raising funds for a new dormitory. the "OOO," a non-profit social development NGO of Cambodia. The Chairman of that NGO, and new partner of PWP, is a past graduate of the Cambodia Maharishi Vedic University, Sambo Huy. The project will begin with a group of 30 students and expand to more and more rural students over the next couple years. Vietnam: PWP is working with Sambo of Cambodia (mentioned previously), plus mediator Lisa Nguyen and TM instructor Hai Dao, both of HCMC, Vietnam, helping them to organize an English teaching institution similar to the very successful one Sambo has in Phenom Phen. The new Vietnamese school has organized locally for all of its start-up capital, and it will dedicate 50% of its net income to support the teaching of the TM program to rural youth in Vietnam.

Support For Africa

Kenya: PWP, working with Raja Wynne and Maureen Wynne, plus Solomon Mwangi, National Leader of Kenya, are focused on several Kenya projects. The first Project is the development of a Consciousness-Based SM Education school for primary and secondary students in Nandi Hills. The second project is supporting the application of the TM program in several private and public institutions in the Mombasa area, primarily focused on providing relief from the realities of PTSD in the life of young people. And a third project is supporting the application of the TM program in a primary school, located near the Tanzanian border, which has been documented to have extensive PTSD among its student population resulting from continued exposure to tribal violence in the area. Uganda: Working with Raja Graham, PWP is generating support mechanisms for two projects in Uganda. The first project is for the Maharishi Secondary School for Girls, which wishes to expand its facilities and increase the number of students. The second project is with the orphanage and school system called EDAPO, where they also wish to improve facilities and increase the number of students. Both projects combined have about 250 meditators and among that group are about 80 students practicing the TM-Sidhi program. Zambia: Working with Raja Peter for Zambia, PWP has helped acquire an existing primary school in the poorer section of Lusaka. This school, now called Maharishi Model School, has been converted to a Consciousness-Based Education institution and a secondary school for girls has now been added for a total of about 300 students. Tanzania: Working with Raja Bruce for Tanzania, PWP is assisting several initiatives in or near the city of Arusha, Tanzania, mostly among the Maasai people of that area. The projects include development of various programs at the TM Center; development of opportunities to teach the TM program to ladies groups in several Maasai villages (around 100 ladies have been taught already and there are hundreds more who want to learn the TM program); creating a Maasai Secondary School for Girls, which will be a Consciousness-Based institution; and finally we are helping provide the Maasai village ladies with financial support for modest agriculture enterprise projects. 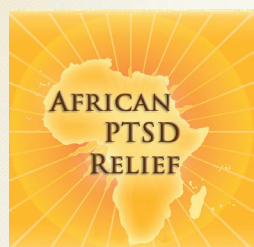
Seeds Of Heaven
